INTRODUCTION

St Andrew's Church is a charismatic, evangelical church in a deprived area of Liverpool. We have seen some growth over recent years and currently have around 150 adults and 30 young people under 18 worshipping with us. We are a mission focused church and have 8 'Missional Communities' led by members of the church.

Over the last 6 years we have seen a number of people in recovery from addiction coming to faith and joining the Church. In response to this we started Celebrate Recovery. This is a Christ centred 12 step recovery program that helps people recover from the hurts, habits and hang ups that hinder their growth as people and also as followers of Jesus.

We now have two Celebrate Recovery groups that meet on Tuesday evening and Thursday morning with total membership of around 40 people.



JOB DESCRIPTION

Once appointed the role will include the following:

1. Taking the lead on the development of our Celebrate Recovery ministry
2. Organise and train our volunteers and to raise up new leaders
3. Ensure the efficient and effect running of our weekly sessions and all that entails.
4. Promote the work of our CR groups across the city
5. Connect regularly with Celebrate Recovery members as and when needed.
6. Maintain a strong connection with other CR groups.
7. Develop good relationships with other recovery groups in our area.
8. Help with the collection, evaluation and sharing of data to establish the how people are coming to faith
9. To be involved in other church ministry as required
